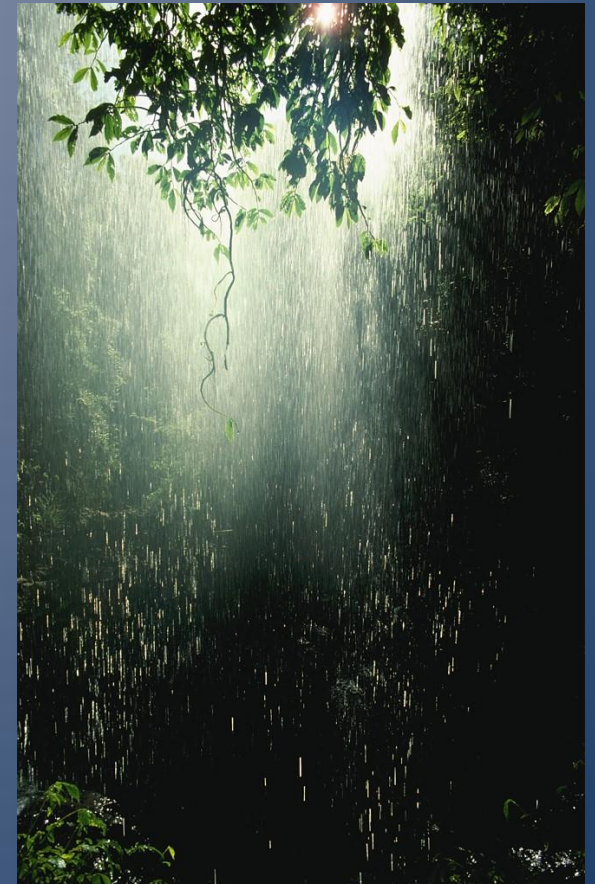

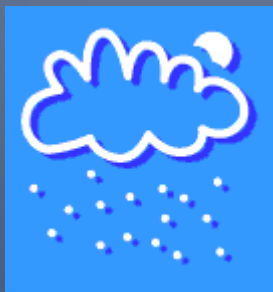
# Marion from Ireland

They don't have a lot of rain in Ireland.



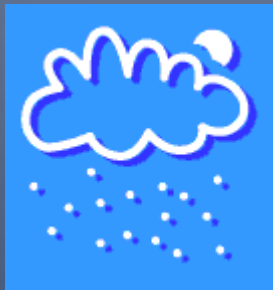
# Marion from Ireland

On a rainy day she phones her friends.



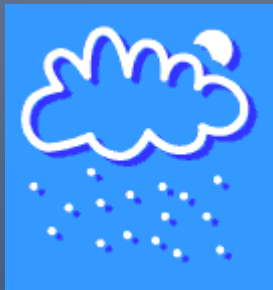
# Kate from New Zealand

# Jeyong from Korea

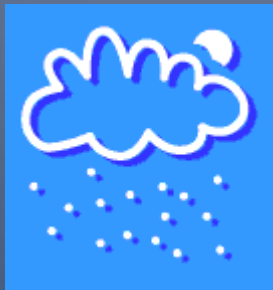
She doesn't like rain because ...

she doesn't have any friends.



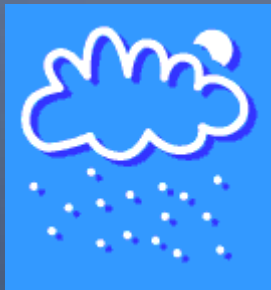
# Jeannie from America

She never takes an umbrella when it rains.



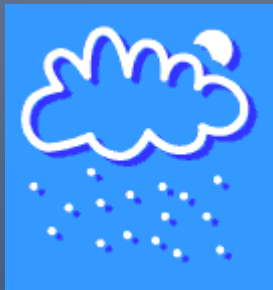
# Barbara from Australia

Rainy days bothers her.



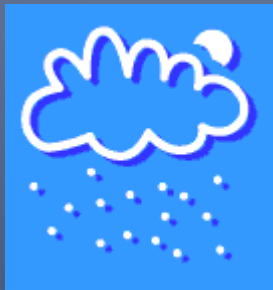
# Barbara from Australia
